Dear Sir/Madam,

I own the stables at the rear of 126 Ansdell Road, Blackpool (FY1 6PF) and have done since 2005. I am concerned about where I would be able to park the vehicle I use for the horses and in connection with their everyday care at the stables, if this Order is made. It is, out of necessity, quite a large vehicle (although not huge) and as such, it is more difficult to find a suitable parking space for than a car.

I used to be able to park this vehicle on the south side of Dunsop Close, where there is now a 'No Waiting At Any Time' restriction and so currently I park it on the north side of Dunsop Close, where you are proposing a further 'No waiting At Any Time' restriction.

If this Order is made and I am no longer able to park the vehicle on the north side of Dunsop Close, then where else would I be able to park it?

I believe it is your intention to revoke the 'Disabled Parking At Any Time' restriction on the south side of Dunsop Close and it has been suggested to me that I would then be able to park the vehicle along this section of the road. However, this would mean parking the vehicle in front of peoples houses and would almost certainly lead to my neighbours getting upset with me for parking it there.

My only other option would be to try and find a suitable place to park the vehicle on one of the other roads nearby. However, I know that space for parking on these roads is already limited and I would also encounter the same problem as I would in Dunsop Close if I tried to park the vehicle in front of someone's house.

Please could you acknowledge receipt of this representation and consider my objection to the proposed Order before making any final decisions.
