

## **LICENSING QUARTERLY UPDATE 2**

### **1.0 Matter for consideration**

- 1.1 The Committee to consider the quarterly update for the period for October to February. The report updates the Committee on licences applied for, dealt with and appealed.

- 3.1 The Licensing Committee has as a key responsibility, a requirement to be informed as to overall details of Licences issued and other statistics on Licensing.
- 3.2 In the period from October to February, the Licensing department have dealt with total of 364 Licence applications, 124 Premises Licence and 240 Personal Licences.
- 3.3 In a similar period, the Council has scheduled a total of 70 hearings of which 41 were cancelled ( 58%) and 29 (42%) were heard.
- 3.4 A total of 11 appeals against the decisions made have been lodged since the Authority has become responsible for Licensing. As the position on these appeals is subject to change, further information will be provided at the Committee meeting.
