Licensing Quarterly Update

1.0 Matter for consideration

1.1 The Committee to consider the quarterly update for the period January-April 2009. The report updates the Committee on licences applied for, dealt with and appealed.

2.0 Recommendation(s)

2.1 To note the update on licences considered, dealt with and appealed.

3.0 Information

- 3.1 The Licensing Committee has as a key responsibility, the requirement to be informed as to overall details of licences issued and other statistics on licensing.
- 3.2 In the period January –April 2009, the Licensing Section have dealt with a total of 20 applications for new premises licences, 13 variation applications, 50 transfers of premises licences, 76 variations of designated premises supervisors and 85 temporary event notices as well as 93 personal licence applications and 7 applications to review premises licences.
- 3.3 In the same period, the Council has scheduled a total of 22 hearings, of which 8 were cancelled due to mediation.
- 3.4 There are three licensing appeals currently outstanding at the Magistrates' Court.
- 3.5 Currently there are 3083 personal licences and 1709 premises licences (1538 authorising the sale of alcohol, 171 not authorising alcohol), and 41 club premises certificates in force.
