- 3.1 Blackpool Council's Statement of Licensing Policy in respect of the Licensing Act 2003 came into effect in January 2008. This policy had effect for a three-year period and must now be reviewed.
- 3.2 The Licensing Committee at its meeting on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2010 approved a draft revised statement of policy for consultation.
- 3.3 Consultation on the draft document will take place until the 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2010. The responses received at the time of writing have been attached. The Committee will be updated at the meeting if any further responses have been received.
- 3.4 The proposed statement of policy has been amended to take into account the comments received
- 3.5 If approved by the Licensing Committee, this policy will be considered by the Executive before being placed on the agenda for the Council meeting to be held on 24<sup>th</sup> November 2010.
