1.1 The Committee to consider the quarterly update for the period January-May 2011. The report updates the Committee on licences applied for, dealt with and appealed.

- 3.1 The Licensing Committee has as a key responsibility, the requirement to be informed as to overall details of licences issued and other statistics on licensing.
- 3.2 In the period January –May 2011, the Licensing Section have dealt with a total of 14 applications for new premises licences, 18 variation applications, 49 transfers of premises licences, 95 variations of designated premises supervisors and 78 temporary event notices as well as 98 personal licence applications and 4 applications to review premises licences.
- 3.3 In the same period, the Council has scheduled a total of 6 hearings, of which 1 was cancelled.
- 3.4 There is one licensing appeal currently outstanding at the Magistrates' Court.
- 3.5 Currently there are 3,602 personal licences and 1,628 premises licences and 38 club premises certificates in force.
