

Licensing Quarterly Update

1.0 Matter for consideration

- 1.1 The Committee to consider the quarterly update for the period June 2012 – October 2012. The report updates the Committee on licences applied for, dealt with and appealed.

2.0 Recommendation(s)

- 2.1 To note the update on licences considered, dealt with and appealed.
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3.0 Information

- 3.1 The Licensing Committee has as a key responsibility, the requirement to be informed as to overall details of licences issued and other statistics on licensing.
- 3.2 In the period June 2012 – October 2012, the Licensing Section have dealt with a total of 29 applications for new premises licences, 10 variation applications, 51 transfers of premises licences, 76 variations of designated premises supervisors and 118 temporary event notices as well as 97 personal licence applications and 1 application to review premises licences.
- 3.3 In the same period, the Council has scheduled a total of 11 hearings, of which 3 were cancelled.
- 3.4 There are no licensing appeals currently outstanding at the Magistrates' Court.
- 3.5 Currently there are 3,915 personal licences and 1,565 premises licences and 36 club premises certificates in force.
