The Health and Safety Authority would like to support this review by showing a history of poor health and safety management.

December 2007

Officer Jacqui Harrison visits and finds the premise being operated by Imad Albayati and that there is little or no health and safety arrangements in place. Nine Improvement Notices are served to include issues around Asbestos Management, poor cleanliness, poor maintenance of gas systems and equipment, poor control of chemicals, poor maintenance of electrical systems and equipment, first aid provision, lack of legal notice displayed and poor sanitary facilities.

July 2011

Officer Jacqui Harrison visits and finds the premise being operated by Imad Albayati and is formerly warned regarding issues including poor management of asbestos, poor management of chemicals, poorly maintained electrical systems and equipment, poor maintenance of gas systems and equipment, poor maintenance of workplace traffic routes.

June 2014

Officer Keith Marsden visits and find the premises being operated by Hamed Mechman. Three Improvement Notices are served to include issues around poor management of gas systems and equipment, poor management of electrical systems and poor maintenance of electrical equipment.

March 2015

Officer Gareth Shaw visits and finds
No Gas certification available Improvement Notice to Serve for this
Gas equipment on cellar requiring further investigation.
Fire Extinguishers out of date.
