Dear Coliseum, 53 Tyldsley Road,

You may remember that you have recently received a letter from JTI and Serve Legal, as part of JTI's commitment to support independent retailers in the North West of England in preventing under age sales of tobacco products.

JTI has been working closely with Serve Legal, an independent company, to mystery shop stores in the area, and to offer training and support to those who may benefit from it. Serve Legal's visitors have again visited your store, and the details of that visit are below.

It is important to remember that Serve Legal's visitors are all over 18 and so, whatever the result of the visit, no laws have been broken. For that reason, the details of your result will not be shared with anybody.

As before, if the visitor was asked for proof of age before he or she was sold tobacco your store will be classified as "compliant". Congratulations - this is good news for you and your team. You should always remain vigilant to prevent children from buying age restricted products.

If the visitor was not asked for proof of age, your store will be classified as "at risk". That means that your store may be at risk of selling tobacco products to under-18s. 
