APPLICATION TO VARY APREMISES LICENCE – Milano's

1.0 Purpose of the report:

1.1 To consider an application to vary a Premises Licence in respect of Milano's, 7 Station Road.

2.0 Recommendation(s):

2.1 The panel are requested to consider the application and determine whether the granting of this licence would adversely impact on the licensing objectives.

3.0 Reasons for recommendation(s):

- 3.1 Representations have been received therefore there must be a hearing to determine the application.
- 3.2a Is the recommendation contrary to a plan or strategy adopted or approved by the Council?
- 3.2b Is the recommendation in accordance with the Council's approved Yes budget?
- 3.3 Other alternative options to be considered:

None, once an application to vary a Premises Licence is received and objections have been received it must be considered by a Licensing Panel.

4.0 **Background Information**

- 4.1 On 11 July 2017, the Licensing Service received an application from Tegi Hassan to vary the premises licence WA0255, Milano's, 7 Station Road.
- 4.2 Currently the premises are licensed for the provision of late night refreshment 23.00
 01.00 hours Sunday Thursday and 23.00 03.00 Friday Saturday.

- 4.3 The application requests an extension of the hours for the provision of late night refreshment 23.00 05.00 hours daily. A copy of the application is attached at Appendix 4a.
- 4.4 Representations have been received from a member of the public. A copy of the representation is attached at Appendix 4b.

4.5 Local policy considerations

None

National policy considerations

9.42 – The authority's decision should be evidence-based, justified as being appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives and proportionate to what it is intended to achieve.

9.43 – Determination of whether an action or step is appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives requires an assessment of what action or step would be suitable to achieve that end. Whilst this does not therefore require a licensing authority to decide that no lesser step will achieve the aim, the authority should aim to consider the potential burden that the condition would impose on the premises licence holder as well as the potential benefit in terms of promotion of the licensing objectives. However, it is imperative that the authority ensures that the factors which form the basis of its determination are limited to consideration of the promotion of the licensing objectives and nothing outside those parameters.

4.6 **Observations**

This licence was granted on 3 January 2017 to Cengiz Bal and was transferred to Mr Hassan on 26 May 2017.

Mr Hassan has served temporary event notices to extend the trading hours until 03.00 on two occasions 25-29 June 2017 and 11-17 July 2017

The following conditions are currently endorsed on the licence:

There are no Annexe 1 conditions because there are no mandatory conditions relating to the provision of late night refreshment.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 1 CCTV, which complies with the following criteria, will be installed at the premises.
 - a The CCTV system shall be installed, maintained and operated to the reasonable satisfaction of Lancashire Constabulary.
 - b The system shall display on any recording the correct time and date of the recording;
 - c The system shall be recording during all hours the premises are open to the public;
 - d VCR tapes or digital recording shall be held for a minimum of 28 days after the recording is made and will be made available to the Police for inspection upon request.
 - e The system shall, as a minimum, record images of the head and shoulders of all persons entering the premises.
 - A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system will be on the premises at all times that the premises are open to the public. This staff member will be able to show police, or any officer acting for a Responsible Authority, recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.
- The licence holder shall notify the Police Licensing Unit on any occasion when the CCTV is to be inoperative for a period in excess of one working day and shall provide a certificate from a competent person stating the reason for the system being inoperative and the measures which have been taken to satisfy the licence conditions.
- Appropriate signage alerting customers to CCTV recording shall be displayed in conspicuous positions on the premises.
- The premises have installed a wall-mounted screen, no smaller than 32", mounted in a prominent position within the premises, so that patrons can view live-recorded CCTV footage.
- 5 There will be no boxing machines in operation in the premises.
- Risk assessments carried out by or on behalf of the Licence Holder which relate to a licensing objective will be available for inspection by an officer or a responsible authority.
- 7 No persons under the age of 16 will be allowed on the premises after 23.00.
- 8 An efficient queuing system will be in operation and the licence holder will

arrange adequate supervision of any queue to prevent disorderly behaviour.



 - o Films: no licence is required for "not-for-profit" film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
 - Indoor Sporting Events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
 - o Boxing or Wrestling: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - o Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - A performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises;
 - A performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500;
 - A performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500;
 - A performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - A performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from (i) the local authority concerned or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
 - o Recorded music: no licence permission is required for:
 - Any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - Any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.

- Any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- o Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - Any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - Any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the healthcare provider;
 - Any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor, and
 - Any entertainment (excluding films and boxing or wrestling taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
- 4. Where taking place in the building or other structure please tick as appropriate. Indoors may include a tent.
- 5. For example state the type of activity to be authorised, if not already stated, and give relevant further details, for example (but not exclusively) whether or not music will be amplified or unamplified.

Subject: Objection to extension of permited hours - Milano's, Station Rd, Blackpool

My wife and I live in a flat immediately above Milano's premises at 7 Station Road in Blackpool and wish to object in the strongest possible terms to any extension to the permitted operating hours of the business for the following reasons:

- 1. We already suffer noise disturbance from the premises (including disturbance in our flat from the noise of the extractor system, noise from customers using tables outside the premises which are capable of seating up to 30 people when all put out, noise from the front door of the premises being closed loudly by customers, noise emitting from the front of the premises itself due to the two glass windows having been removed, noise from the engines of delivery vehicles as well as from the doors and boots of these vehicles being closed and noise from delivery staff taling loudly to each other outside of the premises. All of these disturbances continue until the premises close at night and are having a very detrimental effect upon both my own and my wife's health. Any extension to the permitted trading hours of the premises will result in us suffering noise disturbance and lack of sleep over even more hours. Were this noise disturbance to be allowed to continue until 5am (as per the application) I believe we would be forced to have to move out of our flat and live somewhere else but, as I am registered blind, such a move would cause me particular problems.
- 2. As well as noise disturbance from the various delivery vehicles for the premises which park below our flat, these vehicles are often illegally parked on double yellow lines at the corner of Station Road and Simpsons Street causing danger to both pedestrians and other vehicles, any extension to the permitted trading hours of the premises will further exacerbate this problem. Both Lancashire Police and Blackpool Council Parking Enforcement have been provided with numerous photographs of this illegal parking by me.
- 3. Those running the premises appear to make no attempt to exercise any form of control over those using theoutside seating mentioned above. Often people who appear to be very much under the influence of alcohol use this seating, therefore any extension to the permitted hours of the premises is likely to create an increased risk of crime and disorder in the area. Such behaviour outside the premises is also likely to have a negative effect on the sleep of children staying overnight in the various hotels on the other side of the street.
- 4. My wife and I have personally witnessed flocks of seagulls scooping up large amounts of meat and bread off the street and pavement immediately outside the premises shortly before the premises closes, this already causes severe disturbance to both ourselves and to those sleeping in the hotels opposite, any extension of the permitted hours of the premises is likely to move this issue to an even later hour thereby worsening the disturbance.

- 5. No rubbish bin is provided by the premises for people eating outside to place their rubbish and leftover food in. This causes seagulls to swoop down for food and also results in rubbish being blown around the street. Any extension to the permitted trading hours of the premises is likely to result in more people sitting outside of the premises eating food and thereby increasing the problem of rubbish and leftover food.
- 6. There have been instances of an extremely strong smell of burnt food entering our home from Milano's. If food is ending up being burned then this is very much a public safety issue due to the risk of fire and this risk would increase further if the premises are permitted extended trading hours.

In summar; allowing an extension to the permitted trading hours of Milano's at 7 Station Road in Blackpool will not only have a major adverse effect upon my wife, myself and others but would also be incompatible with all 4 of the licensing ovjectives.

I would therefore respectfully request that the application to extend the operating hours of the above premises be rejected. I would also once again wish to bring to your attention that the premises in question has regularly been operating well beyond it's existing permitted trading hours and continues to do so despite intervention by licensing enforcement officers.
