## TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICES – BUZZ, 5 Dickson Road

### 1.0 Purpose of the report:

- 1.1 To consider Temporary Event Notices submitted by Joseph Warren Basil Newby in respect of events taking place 2-3 June and 9-10 June 2018 at Buzz, 5 Dickson Road, Blackpool.

### 2.0 Recommendation(s):

- 2.1 The panel is requested to consider the objection and determine whether to allow the events to go ahead, add conditions to the Temporary Event Notice or issue a counter notice.

### 3.0 Reasons for recommendation(s):

- 3.1 An objection has been received therefore there must be a hearing to consider whether to issue a counter notice.

### 4.0 Background Information

- 4.1 On 16 May 2018 the Licensing Service was served with temporary event notices on behalf of Buzz, 5 Dickson Road, Blackpool. These notices relate to the provision of regulated entertainment and the sale by retail of alcohol for consumption on the premises to 06.00 hours on Saturday 2 and Sunday 3 June 2018 and Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 June 2018.

4.2 The Police have objected to the events taking place on the ground of preventing crime and disorder. A hearing is therefore required to determine whether a counter notice should be issued to prevent the event from taking place. A copy of the objection is attached.

Section 7 – Temporary Event Notices is relevant

The system of permitted temporary activities is intended to be a light touch process where notice is given by the premises user that they intend to carry out specified activities. The police and environmental health team have three working days to object to the notice on the basis of any of the four licensing objectives.

**Observations**

At the hearing the panel can either let the events go ahead, serve a counter notice to prevent the event going ahead or, after considering the representations, the panel may decide that it is appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives to impose one or more conditions onto the TEN. The panel can only add existing conditions from the premises licence.

The current premises licence (PL1269) permits:

Supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to 03.00 on a Saturday morning (continuing through from Friday night) and to 04.00 on a Sunday morning (continuing through from Saturday night)

Live music, performance of dance and entertainment of a similar description to 03.00 on a Saturday morning and to 04.00 on a Sunday morning

Recorded music to 04.00 on a Saturday morning and to 05.00 on a Sunday morning.

Lancashire Constabulary have requested that the hours are restricted to 04.00 on each day and conditions be added onto the TEN which are on the existing premises licence. A copy of the requested conditions is attached to the Police representation.

Live music, performance of dance and entertainment of a similar description to 03.00 on a Saturday morning and to 04.00 on a Sunday morning

Recorded music to 04.00 on a Saturday morning and to 05.00 on a Sunday morning.

Lancashire Constabulary have requested that the hours are restricted to 04.00 on each day and conditions be added onto the TEN which are on the existing premises licence. A copy of the requested conditions is attached to the Police representation.

<b>Reasons for objecting</b>				
<p>I am in receipt of a Temporary Event Notice at the above premises for the sale of alcohol and provision of regulated entertainment, from 3am to 6am on 16th and 17th June 2018.</p> <p>On behalf of the Police I believe that allowing the premises to be used in accordance with this TEN will undermine the licensing objectives, namely in relation to the prevention of crime and disorder and public safety. There is already a high volume of crime and disorder in the area of Dickson Road and Queen Street and it is believed that by allowing an additional time for alcohol consumption it will exasperate this further.</p> <p>An example of this was on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2018 at 06:07hrs when a large disturbance was reported on Dickson Road involving 30 people with one male unconscious on the floor. A further example was at 06:18hrs on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> April when 20 people were reported to be fighting on the street.</p> <p>Other recent incidents reported to Police when Temporary Event Notices for 6am have been utilised include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Approximately 06:00hrs on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2018 on Dickson Road a fight ensued and a male hit another using a brick causing a laceration down to the bone on another males head.</li> <li>• A report at 06:22hrs on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> January that a male had punched another male causing him to fall to the floor and receive a laceration to his head on Dickson Road. The victim has said he left Flamingo at approximately 05:40hrs and couldn't really remember anything but</li> </ul>				

assumed he's been hit with a bottle.

Therefore, due to the increased risk of crime and disorder Lancashire Constabulary wishes to object to the Temporary Event Notice.

**The Police recommend to the Panel that a Counter Notice be served by the Licensing Authority unless the following restrictions or requirements can be imposed by condition.**

If the licensable activity applied for was restricted to 04:00hrs on both 16th and 17th June 2018 and the below conditions were imposed on the TEN then the Police would be satisfied that the licensing objectives would not be undermined:

1. An adequate number of Licensed door supervisors will be on duty as appropriate to any risk assessment and in accordance with the guidance under the 'Nightsafe' Scheme.
2. All door supervisors are SIA registered.
3. All door staff employed at the entrance / exit of the licensed premises will wear a reflective jacket / tabard of a design approved by the Lancashire Constabulary.
4. CCTV is provided both internally and externally. The CCTV control room will be notified:
  - a) On any occasion when the premises CCTV or radio system is operative.
  - b) When the CCTV or radio system has been brought back into use.
5. The Police Licensing Unit shall be notified on any occasion when the CCTV or radio system is to be inoperative for a period in excess of one working day and shall provide a certificate from a competent person stating the reason for the system being inoperative and the measures which have been taken to satisfy the licence conditions.
6. No under 18s admitted.
7. The Licence holder is to support and rigorously enforce the Challenge 21 proof of age policy. Any person who looks or appears to be under the age of 21 shall be asked to provide identification that they are over the age of 18. The following are the only forms of identification acceptable:
  - i. UK photo driving licence
  - ii. Passport
  - iii. Proof of Age Standards Scheme Card
8. All staff to have received suitable training in relation to the proof of age scheme to be applied upon the premises. Records to evidence this will be made available to an authorised officer upon request
9. Toughened glassware will be used throughout the premises.
10. Appropriate measures will be taken to ensure staff prevent the removal of bottles or glasses from the curtilage and grounds of the licensed premises.
11. At least one personal licence holder will be available on the licensed premises while the supply or sale of alcohol is being undertaken (whose identity will be known to all other staff engaged in the supply or sale of alcohol) except in the case of emergency.
12. Risk assessments carried out by or on behalf of the Licence holder which relate to a licensing objective will be available for inspection by an officer or a Responsible Authority.
13. Where there is reasonable suspicion that drugs are being carried, the licensee shall ensure that the outer clothing, pockets and bags of those entering the venue are searched by a trained staff member.

14. Clearly visible notices, in a form prescribed by the Council, shall be displayed advising those attending that 1. It is a condition of entry that customers agree to be searched and 2. Police will be informed if anyone is found in possession of controlled substances or weapons.

15. Security arrangements are sufficient to discourage the sale and consumption of drugs and shall ensure such arrangements include regular checks of toilet areas

16. Records of incidents involving the use and/or detection of drugs and make those records available for inspection.


17. Confiscated and found drugs shall be stored, disposed, transferred in accordance with procedures agreed with the Lancashire Constabulary.

18. A drugs prevention strategy for the venue shall be developed and applied. The strategy shall include arrangements for the location of posters and the distribution of other information relating to drugs risks, the dangers associated with drugs and the legal provisions relating to drug use.

19. Frequent collection of glasses and bottles will be undertaken to ensure that empty containers do not accumulate in or around the licensed premises.

20. Noise from any Regulated Entertainment or Mechanical Ventilation shall be inaudible within the nearest sensitive properties or, at the discretion of the Local Authority, shall not exceed some other pre-agreed limit, which does not cause unreasonable.
