



- All staff are to have received suitable training in relation to the proof of age scheme to be applied upon the premises. All staff are to receive regular refresher training at intervals of a maximum of 20 six months. Records to evidence this will be made available to an authorised officer upon request.
- An adequate number of licensed door supervisors will be on duty as appropriate to any risk assessment and in accordance with the guidance under the Nightsafe scheme. However on the 21 following occasions at least two SIA registered member of door staff will be on duty from 29.00hrs 21:00 WR until close:

Every Friday and Saturday Bank holiday Sundays, Christmas Eve and New Years Eve When a private function takes place on the premises.

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- Appropriate measures will be taken to ensure staff prevent the removal of bottles or glasses from 22 the curtilage and grounds of the licensed premises.
- Frequent collection of glasses and bottles will be undertaken to ensure that empty containers do 23 not accumulate in or around the licensed premises.
- At least one personal licence holder will be available while the supply or sale of alcohol is being undertaken (whose identity will be known to all other staff engaged in the supply or sale of 24 alcohol) except in the case of emergency.
- Another member of staff shall be nominated to act for the Designated Premises Supervisor, in their absence, whose identity is known by all other staff when such absence occurs. 25
- An authorisation, signed and dated by the Designated Premises Supervisor, shall be kept at the premises showing all persons authorised by them to make sales of alcohol at the premises. 26
- Risk assessments carried out by or on behalf of the licence holder which relate to a licensing objective will be available for inspection by an authorised officer. 27
- The premises shall maintain a drinks policy which complies with any Local Authority resolution made in accordance with approval from the Licensees Forum or any successor body recognised 28 by the Licensing Authority
- All internal lobbied doors to any entrance/exit point, fire exit doors and external windows shall be closed during hours of any regulated entertainment except in the event of an emergency and 29 save for the purposes of access and egress.
- The premises shall be operated in participation with the "Pubwatch" and "Radiolink" schemes. 30
- All door staff employed at the entrance/exit of the the licensed premises will wear a reflective 31
