Dear Tracey Reeves,

Re: Queen Victoria, 23 Dickson Road, Blackpool, FY1 2AT.

In relation to the Licensing Act 2003 I would like to bring to your attention the fact that as of the 24th November 2005 the new licensing act came into force and will be rigorously enforced by all of the enforcement officers in the town.

On Saturday 12th April 2014 at 14:50hrs, the above premises were visited and found to be operating outside the conditions of the premises licence as outlined below.

19 At least one personal licence holder will be available on the licensed premises while the sale of alcohol is being undertaken (whose identity will be known to all other staff engaged in the supply or sale of alcohol) except in the case of emergency.

At the time of my visit there was only one member of staff present; Josh Robinson and he was not a personal licence holder. Please ensure that whilst alcohol is being served there is a personal licence holder on the premises.

I would also advise that in accordance with section 136 (1) of The Licensing Act 2003 "A person commits an offence if a) he carries on or attempts to carry on a licensable activity on or from any premises otherwise than in accordance with an authorisation, b) he knowingly allows a licensable activity to be so carried on".

The maximum penalty for this offence is six months imprisonment and/or a fine not exceeding £20,000.

Please take this letter as a formal warning that if your premises are found to be operating outside the conditions again then formal proceedings will be taken.

A copy of this letter will be retained on your premises file and maybe used against you in subsequent hearings.
