On Friday 19th February 2016 Public Protection Officer (PPO) Dave Verity from Blackpool Councils Licensing Enforcement department working in company with PPO Jacqui Harrison a Health & Safety officer from Blackpool Council, were on duty conducting Licensing visits part of the duty was to visit premises where the Premises licence had been suspended for non-payment of the annual renew fee to establish if the premises were still stocking or selling alcohol. At approximately 20.45 hrs PPO Verity and Harrison attended the Osprey hotel situated at 27 Charnley Road, Blackpool. This hotel has previously benefitted from a premises licence (PL0705) to supply and sell alcohol issued by Blackpool Council. This licence was suspended on 25th September 2014 for non-payment of renewal fees.

As the officers approached the front door they could see into the ground floor front room of the hotel and saw a small bar to the rear of the room the bar was illuminated.

On knocking on the front door a male appeared, PPO Verity identified himself as a Licensing Enforcement officer for Blackpool Council, PPO Verity further explained the reason for the visit was to check the bar area and explained that the premises licence for the Osprey Hotel had been suspended in September 2014. PPO verity asked the male his name and the male stated his name to be STEVEN NOTTAGE who then stated the bar had not been in use for the last eighteen months. PPO Verity then requested to see the bar area NOTTAGE was a little reluctant stating his wife was ill but NOTTAGE eventually invited PPO Verity and PPO Harrison into the property and were shown into the front room. PPO Verity immediately saw the bar area which was illuminated and had optics attached to the wall of the bar each of the optics contained a bottle of spirits each bottle had varying amounts of alcohol inside them. There was also a cash register on top of the bar and clean drinking glasses on shelves behind

the bar. PPO Verity also noticed a premises licence summary on the wall behind the bar PPO Verity requested to see the licence summary NOTTAGE took the summary off the wall and passed it to PPO Verity on inspection the summary was PL0705 PPO Verity immediately saw that the licence and the Designated Premises supervisor was in the name of Dinesh Modi.

STEVEN NOTTAGE then explained that Dinesh Modi was the previous owner of the business. I

Then asked to look in the cash register but there was only a few coins inside.PPO Verity explained to STEVEN NOTTAGE that because the licence was suspended even though there was no customers drinking in the bar offences were still being committed under Sections 137 and 138 of the licensing Act 2003 in relation to exposing alcohol for unauthorised sale and keeping alcohol on the premises for unauthorised sale. PPO Verity cautioned STEVEN NOTTAGE who made no immediate reply to caution. PPO Verity then asked NOTTAGE if he agreed that if the bar had not been used for eighteen months the alcohol, drinking glasses and bar fittings would have been removed by now. NOTTAGE then replied "YES" PPO Verity then said to NOTTAGE "I suggest that you have been running the bar serving alcohol using the old premises licence PL0705 NOTTAGE then replied "YES I HAVE" PPO Verity then advised NOTTAGE that he would be reported for the offences committed under the licensing act 2003.

PPO Verity then took photographic evidence of the bar with the alcohol on display with NOTTAGE in the picture and the old premises licence summary in the name of Dinesh Modi PPO Verity advised NOTTAGE to remove the alcohol from display.

PPO Harrison then spoke to NOTTAGE in relation to Health & Safety then both officers left the osprey hotel.

On return to the office the following week and checking the Council computer records PPO Verity discovered that NOTTAGE had been aware of the licence being suspended further enquiries with the licensing admin officers confirmed that NOTTAGE had been contacted and spoken to in relation to the problems with the licence and had made no effort to rectify the situation. On Friday 18th November 2016 STEVEN NOTTAGE appeared before Blackpool Magistrates the Councils Case was presented by Michael Caveney. **The following is an email of the court result sent by Mr Caveney to PPO Dave Verity.**

Steven & Gloria Nottage, The Osprey Hotel.....

Hi

I attended BMC this morning to represent the Council in this matter.

Steven Nottage was in attendance and unrepresented, Gloria Nottage was not in attendance.

Council witnesses in attendance were: Sarah Hawley, David Verity, Jacqui Harrison, Keith Marsden.

After a brief chat before court, Steven Nottage was left pondering a decision to plead or run his own case. The Court Clerk then spoke to him and he appeared to be obtaining some pro bono advice from a solicitor who previously represented him but could not get legal aid.

Steven Nottage pleaded guilty, to 4 of 6 charges, he denied on 5th August selling, and Having in possession with intent to supply. In light of that; I offered no evidence of those two matters.

I presented the Council's case and the Magistrates' retired.

They fined him £1500 each on counts 1-3 with 10% discount for a guilty plea.

They fined him £2000 count 5 from 5th August. The fine reflecting the aggravating fact that David Verity had instructed him to take the alcohol off display.

That came to £5850

Costs were awarded against him in the sum of £500. (£250 investigation, £250 legal) Victim surcharge of £170.

Total £6520 to be paid at £250 per month by direct debit.

Collection order made.

I then presented the case of Gloria Nottage to proceed in her absence. The court wished to adjourn, but I stated that she had been properly served, had been written to by the court and should have attended. Mr Nottage had said she was in Oxford but still lived in Blackpool at the Osprey for now.


The court did agree to hear the matter. Given the fines metered above, and the fact that Mrs Nottage had never attended court to enter a plea, I withdrew charges 1-4 and 6. This would secure a conviction so that she would find it difficult to obtain a licence in future.


She was fined £1000, no order for costs and a £100 victim surcharge. A collection order being made, the full amount to be paid within 21 days.

Spoke to Mr nottage again who is the tennant at the hotel. He has tried to contact Mr Modi on the number he has for him but the number is not obtainable = 07091333400.

He pays his rent via direct debit.

I suggested to Mr Nottage that it would be best if he obtained his own personal licence and transfered the licence into his name that way he would have more control. He is booked on a course already.

I explained that the licence is suspended for non-payment of the annual fee and we did need to speak to Mr Modi urgently - also explained that it is an offence to serve alcohol whilst the licence is suspended.
