# Details of your representation in support of the review application (Please reference & attach supporting any documentation)

The Review is brought by Mark Marshall from Blackpool Council following serious concerns regarding irresponsible trading. This application is made in support of this Review and the Police will present evidence that the Licensing Objectives of prevention of crime and disorder and public safety have been undermined.

On 5<sup>th</sup> August 2016 Claudia Badea, the current DPS, signed a Mediation Agreement in relation to conditions that police requested to be placed on the new premises licence for Bucharest. Two of the conditions were:

- 6) Any alcohol over the ABV of 6% is to be located behind a point of sale area
- 7) No single cans of lager, cider or bitter to be sold

Prior to signing the Mediation Agreement the document was sent to Ms Badea so she could look over the conditions and had the opportunity to discuss any issues prior to any licence being granted. Having no issues with the conditions proposed The Agreement was signed and subsequently all conditions were placed on the licence.

Within a month information came to light that single cans of 9% lager were being sold in direct breach of the two conditions highlighted.

Talbot Road is part of the Saturation Zone and is a particular problem area for the local Community Policing Team. A significant portion of their time is focussed on street drinkers and the associated disorder. The selling of single cans is a particular problem and is key factor in attracting the street drinkers to the area. The selling of single cans we believe encourages them to drink more which in turn is detrimental to their health and well-being. In addition to this there has been an increase in the number of empty cans being discarded on the streets nearby.

In the past week, since beginning of February, there have been several calls to area immediately surrounding this premises in relation to nuisance caused by the street drinkers/homeless hanging around in the area. Attached to this report are 4 police logs dealt with by the neighbourhood team. The logs show that this is occurring during daylight hours, when families and children are in the area.

As this area has a significant problem with alcohol abuse it is key that any licensed premise, whether on or off licences, trades responsibly and promotes the licensing objectives. From the evidence presented police are of the opinion that the crime and disorder and public safety objectives are being undermined and the premises licence holder has traded irresponsibly and therefore fully support Mr Marshall in his Representation.

- All staff to have received suitable training in relation to the proof of age scheme to be applied upon the premises. Records to evidence this will be made available to an authorised officer upon request. Refresher training shall be conducted every 6 months as a minimum.
- 3. All staff to have received suitable training in relation to not serving to persons suspected of being drunk. Records to evidence this will be made available to an authorised officer upon request. Refresher training shall be conducted every 6 months as a minimum.
- 4. Ordinarily a member of management team will be on the premises at all times the premises are open to the public. In exceptional circumstances where this is not the case another member of staff will be given responsibility of the premises and all staff will have knowledge of who this person in responsibility is.
- 5. The primary purpose of the premises is to operate as a food retailer and the sale of alcohol is ancillary to the retail of food.
- 6. Any alcohol over the ABV of 6% is to be located behind a point of sale area.
- 7. No single cans of lager, cider or bitter to be sold.
- 8. CCTV will be installed internally and externally at the premises and will comply with the following:

The CCTV system shall be installed, maintained and operated to the reasonable satisfaction of Lancashire Constabulary. All public areas of the premises are to be covered by the system. The system will incorporate a camera covering each of the entrance doors and will be capable of providing an image which is regarded as identification standard. The system will display on any recording the correct time and date of the recording. The system will make recordings during all hours the premises are open to the public. VCR tapes or digital recording shall be held for a minimum of 21 days after the recording is made and will be made available to the Police or any authorised persons acting for a Responsible Authority for inspection upon request.

The system will, as a minimum, record images of the head and shoulders of all persons entering the premises.

- 9. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system will be on the premises at all times the premises are open to the public. This staff member will be able to show recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested to a Police Officer or to a Local Authority Enforcement Officer.
- 10. The Licence Holder or Designated Premises Supervisor shall notify the Police Licensing Unit on any occasion when the CCTV is to be inoperative for a period in excess of one working day and shall provide a certificate from a competent person stating the reason for the system being inoperative and the measures which have been taken to satisfy the licence conditions.

- 11. Appropriate signage alerting customers to CCTV recording shall be displayed in conspicuous positions on the premises.
- 12. An authorisation of sales, signed and dated by the DPS, shall be kept at the premises showing all persons authorised by them to make sales of alcohol at the premises.
- 13. An incident book will be maintained, in which shall be recorded:
  - (i) All incidents of crime and disorder
  - (ii) Refused sales to suspected under age/ drunken persons
  - (iii) A record of any person refused admission or asked to leave the premises
  - (iv) Details of occasions upon which the Police are called to the premises
  - (v) The use or discovery of drugs

That book shall be available for inspection by a Police Officer or authorised person
