REPLACEMENT OF SPANISH HALL ROOF AND RESTORATION OF CORONATION STREET FAÇADE – BLACKPOOL WINTER GARDENS

1.0 Purpose of the report:

1.1 To seek approval, subject to funding to the appointment of Conlon Construction Limited to undertake replacement of the Spanish Hall Roof and Restoration works to Coronation Street Façade of the Winter Gardens.

2.0 Recommendation(s):

2.1 To approve the appointment of Conlon Construction Limited to undertake replacement of the Spanish Hall Roof and Restoration works to Coronation Street Façade of the Winter Gardens. The appointment would be subject to final funding approval.

3.0 Reasons for recommendation(s):

3.1 A mini-competition from the North West Construction Hub framework has been undertaken between February and March 2017 in order to a select a contractor to undertake the replacement of the Spanish Hall Roof and Restoration works to Coronation Street Façade of the Winter Gardens.

Pre-construction activity will take place during March and April 2017. The contract period is scheduled to take commence in July 2017.

Two contractors participated in the mini-competition;

- Conlon Construction Limited
- F. Parkinson Ltd

Following evaluation Conlon Construction Limited were deemed to have submitted the most economically advantageous bid meeting all of the requirements and the intention is to enter into a contract with them.

5.0 Background Information

- 5.1 Blackpool Council is seeking to appoint a suitably experienced Building Contractor to carry out the replacement of the Spanish Hall Roof and Restoration works to Coronation Street Façade of the Winter Gardens.
- 5.2 The Council must continue the significant programme of restoration and redevelopment works to the Winter Gardens. This phase of works will involve the repair, restoration and re-glazing of the Spanish Hall roof and the repair and stabilization of ceramic finishes to the Coronation Street façade of the Olympia Building.
- 5.3 The works will be required to be undertaken whilst the facility remains operational with a number of planned events taking place during the contract period.
- A mini-competition exercise has been undertaken from the North West Construction Hub's Low Value design and build framework. Invitations to Tender were issued through The Chest (NW e-tendering portal). Of the eight contractors registered on the framework for Lot 7 (Design and Construct Lancashire Region), three registered an interest and invitations were issued to them on 26 January 2017. One supplier opted out of the tender, and the remaining two returned tender submissions in accordance with the conditions of the invitation to tender.
