THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROADS)
(TWENTY MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (hereafter referred to as 'the Council') in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter referred to as the 'Act of 1984') and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police pursuant to Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order.

COMMENCEMENT AND CITATION

1. THIS Order shall come into operation on the ~~XX^{xx}~~ ~~Xxxxxx~~ 2017 and may be cited as "THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROADS) (TWENTY MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017"

INTERPRETATIONS

2. IN this Order except where the content otherwise expressly requires the following words or expressions shall have these meanings assigned to them;-

"Plan A" means the plan marked A attached to this Order.

"vehicle" shall be taken to include non-motor vehicles.

The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 as amended or by or under any other enactment.

Any reference in this Order to a statute or regulation shall be construed to such statute or regulation as the same may have been or may from time to time be amended or re-enacted.

TWENTY MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT

3. SAVE as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding twenty mile per hour at anytime in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

EXEMPTION FROM TWENTY MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT

4. NOTHING in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to exceed a speed of twenty miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order if the vehicle is being used by the Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service or Police Service in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
