Your local Councillors have listened to residents in the area, many of whom are concerned about the speed of traffic on Ashburton Road. The Councillors have suggested that the existing traffic calming scheme on Egerton Road and Sherbourne Road be extended.

It is proposed that speed cushions are introduced on Ashburton Road, this road is a bus route therefore the proposed traffic calming measures will take the form of bus friendlier 75mm high flat topped road humps. A plan showing the proposal is on the back of this letter.
