Dear Sirs

I have an office at 23a Westcliffe Drive and wish to object to the application by Mr Janusz Artur Kuca for an alcohol premises licence at 13 Westcliffe Drive.

Firstly there are already numerous outlets in the Layton area selling alcohol, including one next door to the applicant. Infact, I would say that the area is already saturated with licensed premise and amongst the many facilities we require here, another shop selling alcohol is not one of them.

Our front door is slightly recessed and it already attracts unsavoury elements who gather at night, light up cigarettes, drink alcohol, leave litter and occasionally use it as a urinal. An additional licensed outlet is only likely to make this situation worse.

The incidence of unruly and abusive behaviour seems to be on the rise in Layton, it may only be a perception but the area is certainly not the pleasant and peaceful place it was some years ago. It would seem to me that an additional store selling alcohol, will only lead to more public nuisance.

Layton is an area frequented by many school children and I would respectfully advise the Licensing Committee to give this much thought when considering the application.
