On reading the evidence supplied in the application to review this licence it is clear that the takeaway Heatwave has been operating beyond the terminal hour of 04.00 hours.

I am aware of an incident from 16th July 2017 when Police found a 13 year old boy on the premises buying food at 05.00 hours. This was referred on to social services. The premises have a condition annex 2 no. 3 "No persons under the age of 16 will be allowed on the premises after 23.00 hours".

I believe that the management of the premises have failed to support the licensing objective of Preventing Crime and Disorder, the Prevention of Public Nuisance and Protecting Children from Harm.
