## Academic standards at Secondary School level

The Attainment 8 score is down on 2016 but the proportion of pupils achieving EBacc is up.

When indirectly comparing pupils achieving 4-9 and 5-9 grades in English and Maths with pupils achieving 5 A*-Cs in 2016, the \% achieving 4-9 is relatively close to the previous GCSE results, but there is a noticeable drop when comparing with the $\%$ achieving 5-9.

Girls are outperforming boys when it comes to English, Attainment 8 and EBacc, but boys are on a par with girls for Maths.

Those pupils who do not fall under pupil premium outperform those who do across the board.


When comparing with 2016 results, Attainment 8 in 2017 decreased across all these groups, while Achieving EBacc improved for all groups with the exception of Boys.
