- 5.4 Councillor Mrs Henderson MBE and Hunter of Highfield Ward have requested £6,000 as funding to the Highways Department for the re-surfacing of roads between Cheddar Avenue and Farnell Place and between Cheddar Avenue and Primrose Avenue.
- 5.5 Councillors Roberts and Stanfield of Stanley Ward have requested £1,190 as funding to the Illuminations Department for the purchase and installation of 14 mounted 6ft Christmas trees with LED lighting on Common Edge Road.
- 5.6 Councillors Cox and Humphreys of Squires Gate Ward have requested £5,300 as funding to the Alley Gates Team for the purchase and installation of 2 alley gates at Roselyn Avenue.
