It is still however allocated as school playing field and to dispose of the land would require an Application for Secretary of State's consent under Section 77 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998.
- 5.2 Langdale Free School have expressed an interest in utilising an area of the former Bispham High School site as playing fields and this proposal will not remove their interest in that area of land
- 5.3 Langdale Free School has been in contact with the head teacher and the governing body at Holy Family Catholic Primary School who have no objection to them using the site. An e mail from the head teacher has been received.
