- 5.4 Councillors Campbell and Kirkland of Park Ward have requested £2,080 as funding to Horan Shukokai Centre towards venue hire for the centre at Boundary Primary School and for security costs at Boundary Primary School.
- 5.5 Councillors Collett and Matthews of Tyldesley Ward have requested £440 as funding to the Environmental Services Department for the purchase and installation of a new mixed waste bin at the junction of Grasmere Road and Bloomfield Road.
