My objection relates to prevention of public nuisance.

The premises name "late lounge" hints at the hours it's likely to operate.

There are many residents in this area that go to bed at a reasonable hour to be able to get up for work the following day. The last thing we need in this area, is another establishment serving alcohol, creating noise nuisance associated with this type of venue.

It's inevitable there will be an increase in footfall, traffic, noise at closing time.

After a certain time of night, this is generally a quiet neighbourhood, this isn't a suitable area for this type of business.

Other relatively recently licensed premises in this area, highlight the amount of disturbance created for local residents to endure on a regular basis.

The town centre would be a better location to open a bar/pub.
