We are applying for a small extension to our licenced hours. for the purpose of serving alcohol.

Having been operational now for almost 5 years, we are aware that this would give us an opportunity to make this business more viable.

We have a good track record with both the police and licensing, having received good feedback from both.

Uniquely, we presently offer our premises, free of charge for the celebration of birthdays, anniversaries & the like. Due to the type of premises we are in, these are not private events & we remain open to the public during these celebrations. However we do provide a free hot & cold buffet, which enables people, who otherwise may not have the spare income, the opportunity to get together & celebrate. We have very little history of anti social behaviour or adverse impact on our local community, as the police will attest.

We believe this small extension of hours would make the venue more appealing to local residents, who currently having to go into town, attracted by the later hours. We offer better value for money & a safer environment.
