- 6.1 The Council's delegated budgets scheme allocates budgets of £15,000 to each Ward covered for the financial year 2020/2021. The funding for this scheme can be spent on supplementing funding public services, for the benefit of the local community.

 (ii)£3,180 as funding to the Illuminations Department for the purchase and installation of 2 large LED lit Christmas Trees in Clifton Ward.
- 6.3 Councillors R Scott and Wing of Greenlands Ward have requested £1,590 as funding to the Illuminations Department for the purchase and installation of a large LED lit Christmas Tree in Greenlands Ward.
- 6.4 Councillor Hunter of Highfield Ward has requested £1,590 as funding to the Illuminations Department for the purchase and installation of a large LED lit Christmas Tree in Highfield Ward. This application is submitted as a solo application due to Cllr Mrs Henderson MBE being unable to provide a signature due to her current illness.
- 6.5 Councillors Cross and Farrell of Ingthorpe Ward have requested £840 as funding to the Illuminations Department to supply lighting for the two permanent Christmas Trees in Ingthorpe Ward.
