#### 3.0 Information

Good progress has been made in most areas. Points to note relating to those currently rated as red include:

- Fylde and Wyre Borough Councils have not yet contributed to Alcohol Liaison Nurse Service despite agreeing during December 2012.
- Identification and Brief Advice training commissioning currently out to Prior Information Notification.
- Reduction in road safety team may impact on alcohol road safety actions, discussions are in place with Public Health to best address the issues.
- Early Morning Restriction Order hearing took place February 3-7<sup>th</sup> 2014.
- No progress on training for Magistrates but not due until 2015
- Licensing actions mainly due for 2015 to allow for implementation of actions resulting from the Early Morning Restriction Orderhearing.
- Alternative entertainment venues being considered through Fairness Commission.
- No Alcohol Harm Reduction Champions identified.
- New training courses and registration systems being developed for all alcohol retailers.
- Post filled to implement Healthy Workplaces across Blackpool.
- Young people's non -formal education scheme commissioned.
- School PSHE project investment made, no post holder appointed to date.
