

7. FORMATION OF A PUBLIC PROTECTION SUB-COMMITTEE

Matter for Consideration

Dependent on the decision of Council, to reconstitute the Public Protection Sub-Committee

Information

At its meeting on the 31<sup>st</sup> January 2005, the Licensing Committee agreed to create a politically balanced Sub-Committee of 8 members to be formed from the Licensing Committee to deal with the functions previously dealt with by the Public Protection Committee, namely Licences not dealt with under the Licensing Act 2002. as outlined in Part Three of the Council's Constitution.

The Council at its meeting on the 16<sup>th</sup> November 2005, will consider making a number of changes to the present Committee Structure. Any changes which are made will be reported to the Licensing Committee meeting. In light of any decisions made at this meeting the Committee may be required to consider whether it wishes to reconstitute the Public Protection Sub-Committee.
