Alcohol related Crime Blackpool

Data was obtained for the 1-year period 1st November 2021-31st October 2022 from Lancashire Constabulary's investigation recording system Connect and mapped and extracted for the relevant area Blackpool. The data was then filtered to contain offences that were alcohol related¹.

Lancashire Constabulary installed a new IT system on the 27th November 2018. Please note that crime data obtained from police crime intelligence system is subject to change. From dip sampling it is believed there is an underestimation due to issues with quality assurance, geocoding and additional coding problems.

- During the period 1st November 2021-31st October 2022, there were 3,573 **Alcohol related** crimes recorded in Blackpool.
 - **Alcohol related** offences accounted for 15% (3573/23898) of all crime recorded for the period in Blackpool.
- The below table shows the breakdown of the **Alcohol related** crimes recorded for the period.
 - 68% (2442/3573) of the **Alcohol related crimes** recorded were Violence against the person offences.
 - 8% (293/3573) were Public Order offences and 8% (280/3573) were Arson and Criminal Damage offences.

- The peak wards for **Alcohol related** crimes included Clarendon (n=852, 24%), Talbot (n=693, 19%) and Bloomfield (n=541, 15%).
 - Clarendon (n=852), Talbot (n=693) and Bloomfield (n=541) recorded 58% (2086/3573) of the offences for the period.

¹ Please note, there could be some under-reporting due to the reliance on an alcohol marker being selected.

- The greatest proportion of **Alcohol related** crimes to all crimes recorded for the period occurred in:
 - Claremont- 25% (852 of 3,392 crimes were **Alcohol related**)
 - Talbot- 18% (693 of 3,898 crimes were **Alcohol related**)
 - Bloomfield- 17% (541 of 3,242 crimes were **Alcohol related**)
 - Waterloo- 15% (195 of 1,286 crimes were **Alcohol related**)
 - Norbreck- 15% (64 of 419 crimes were **Alcohol related**)
