- 3. That Alan Gerard Ogden will not be on the premises at any time.

- 4. Doors and windows to be closed at all times that regulated entertainment is taking place other than for access and egress.
- 5. A noise assessment report will be obtained prior to regulated entertainment recommencing and any recommendations will be implemented.
