APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE – 13 Clifton Street

1.0 Purpose of the report:

1.1 To consider an application for a premises licence at 13 Clifton Street.

2.0 Recommendation(s):

2.1 The panel is requested to consider the application and determine whether the granting of this licence would adversely impact on the licensing objectives.

3.0 Reasons for recommendation(s):

- 3.1 Representations have been received therefore there must be a hearing to determine the application.
- 3.2a Is the recommendation contrary to a plan or strategy adopted or approved by the Council?
- 3.2b Is the recommendation in accordance with the Council's approved Yes budget?
- 3.3 Other alternative options to be considered:

None, once an application has been submitted and representations received it must be considered by the Licensing Panel.

4.0 **Background Information**

- 4.1 On 18 May 2015, the licensing service received an application from Sripathmanathan Rajkumar to issue a premises licence at 13 Clifton Street Blackpool.
- 4.2 The application requests permission to sell alcohol for consumption off the premises 06.00 23.00 hours daily. A copy of the application is attached.

4.3 Representations have been received from Lancashire Constabulary, Public Health and the Licensing Authority. Copies of the representations are attached.

4.4 Local policy considerations

This premises is situated within Talbot ward which is one for four wards that form part of the off-licence saturation policy. The effect of this policy is to create a rebuttable presumption that applications will be refused. To rebut this presumption, an applicant would be expected to show through the operating schedule, and where appropriate with supporting evidence, that the operation of the premises will not add to the cumulative impact already being experienced.

Applicants for licences within this area will be expected to cover the issues detailed below in their operating schedule. Failure to do so may result in the refusal of the application:

- Details of proof of age scheme to be implemented and proposals for staff training
- Percentage of premises to be used for the sale of alcohol, including details of other items to be sold
- The applicant's policy on the sale of low value/high alcohol products and any drinks discounting that would be adapted.

4.5 National policy considerations

9.12 – The police are an essential source of advice and information on the impact and potential impact of licensable activities, particularly on the crime and disorder objective. The licensing authority should accept all reasonable and proportionate representations made by the police unless the authority has evidence that do so would not be proportionate for the promotion of the licensing objectives.

9.42 – The authority's decision should be evidence-based, justified as being appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives and proportionate to what it is intended to achieve.

13.35 – After receiving relevant representations in relation to a new application for or a variation of a licence or certificate, the licensing authority must consider whether it would be justified in departing from its special policy in the light of the individual circumstances of the case... if the licensing authority decides that an application should be refused, it will still need to show that the grant of the application would undermine the promotion of one of the licensing objectives and that appropriate conditions would be ineffective in preventing the problems involved.



I am in receipt of an application for a New Premises Licence for the above address.

On behalf of the Chief Officer of Police, having reviewed the application the Police make formal objections on the following grounds:

The Police base this objection on the existing Premises Licence being within the Off Licence Saturation Policy Area. The purpose of this Policy is to limit the number of Off Licensed Premises within a given geographic area, in order to reduce crime and disorder and promote the licensing objectives. The Policy sets out the following;

The number, type and density of the premises selling alcohol in a
particular area can lead to serious problems of nuisance and
disorder. In these circumstances the impact of the premises taken
as a whole can be far greater than that arising from individual
premises. In most cases it would be impossible to identify an

individual premise as being the sole cause or major contributing factor.

- The potential impact on the promotion of the licensing objections by a significant number of licensed premises concentrated in one area is called cumulative impact. The cumulative impact of all the premises in an area upon the promotion of the licensing objectives is a proper matter for the Licensing Committee to consider.
- This application is within the saturation zone. The location of the proposed premises is in the centre of town, servicing both the day time and night time economy. These premises will only add to the availability of alcohol and increase crime and disorder.

The proposed new premises falls within the Talbot Ward of Blackpool, which is surrounded by Bars, HMO, Hotels, Holiday Flats, and numerous business premises most of these with an alcohol licence.

The Talbot Ward already consists of 25 premises that are Off Licences this is not including the other premises with an alcohol licence.

Talbot Ward itself is a deprived area which already has high levels of Anti Social Behaviour, Domestic Violence and Violent Crime, and alcohol is well documented to be a contributing factor to these sorts of issues. Another premises making alcohol easily accessible will only add to the Crime and Disorder.

I also have concerns that the Licence Holder/Designated Premises Supervisor has not been a DPS within the Blackpool Area and therefore has no experience of the area and its surroundings. I have not been able to find out any previous information in relation to the proposed DPs and therefore cannot comment if he has any previous knowledge of the day to day running of a Licensed premise or if this will be his first role as a DPS and he may not be suitable to take on a high risk premises due to his inexperience.

The applicant has also provided limited conditions covering the four Licensing Objectives and has not stipulated what proportion of the premises will be for the retail of alcohol.

The applicant has requested his hours of alcohol sales to be 6am-11pm, this is of great concern as premises that have been open during the night time economy will be closing their doors just as this proposed premise will be opening allowing patrons to purchase more alcohol after already being heavily fuelled from an evening of drinking which will lead to a 24hour drinking culture.

A hearing would allow the Licensing Committee to examine the prospective operators' intentions and rebut the presumption that the operation of the premises will not add to the cumulative impact and therefore crime and disorder.

Reasons for making representations

The Public Health Department, Blackpool Council, write in reference to the new Premises Licence application for 13 Clifton Street, Blackpool.

The applicant brings this application in full knowledge that this store is located within Talbot ward which has been subject to the Cumulative Impact Policy (CIP) since 2009.

As stated in Blackpool Council's Statement of Licensing Policy –

The effect of the policy is to create a rebuttable presumption that applications listed above will be refused. To rebut this presumption, an applicant would be expected to show through the operating schedule, and where appropriate, with supporting evidence, that the operation of the premises will not add to the cumulative impact already being experienced.

Following review of this application, Public Health, Blackpool Council, make a formal objection due to the following concerns:

Supply of Alcohol-

Public Health has concerns that the applicant has applied to supply alcohol from 6.00am; if this application is successful this will increase the availability of alcohol supply within the Saturation Area in the early morning period. Public Health has concerns that these additional hours may have a detrimental impact on Crime and Disorder and Public Nuisance (2 of the licensing objectives) within the local area.

Public Health has concerns that this new premises is situated in an area where there are also a large number of premises that sell alcohol (on and off sales) within close proximity to Clifton Street.

Sale of low value/high alcohol products and any drinks discounting -

Within the Operating Schedule the applicant has not stated their policy on the sale of low value/high alcohol products and any drinks discounting that would be adopted. Once again the sale of cheap high strength alcohol and discounted offers within this premise could have a negative impact on the licensing objectives - Crime and Disorder and Public Nuisance; due to the local demographics and potential clientele groups.

Local Area Concerns -

In addition under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003, Para.8.34, applicants are expected to demonstrate their knowledge of local issues and what they will do to adopt strategies to avoid the exasperation of such issues. The application is completely void of this important information. The applicant demonstrates an inadequate understanding of the area and had failed to demonstrate in their application that their operation would not add to the existing issues already impacting on this area. Paragraph 8.37 of the Section 182 rightly suggests that information to applicants should be readily available; both Blackpool Health Profile 2014 and the Blackpool Drug and Alcohol Health Needs Assessment are public documents which are available yet have not been considered by the applicant.

As stated in the Statement of Licensing Policy the burden of proof rests with the applicant in this case.

Paragraph 9.30 of the Section 182 suggests that it is good practice for applicants to contact the Responsible Authorities before formulating their application. No contact from the applicant has been received.

Public Health would ask the Licensing Committee to consider the potential risks associated with the increase in the availability of alcohol within this Saturation Area in their deliberations as to whether to grant this application.

I submit this representation on behalf of the Licensing Authority, the premises sits within Talbot Ward which is subject to a special policy where the presumption is to refuse the application.

Blackpool has 4 wards subject to the same test but Talbot ward has the greatest number of Off Licence outlets with 25. The next highest being Bloomfield with 23.

The application is limited in content and does not deal with many of the issues that prevail in the area such as;

Alcohol dependency Street Drinkers High Strength Alcohol Underage sales and consumption Proxy Sales

The level of crime in the area which has an alcohol related element is significant and there is a clear correlation between the excessive availability of alcohol and crime in the area as such the Committee should be minded to refusing this application which would be supportive of their own Statement of Licensing Policy

This application in particular fails to address many of the areas of the Statement of Licensing policy in particular, high strength alcohol, the amount of shop space that will be dedicated to alcohol displays, discounting and offers.

The next matter that is not dealt with is the proximity of similar premises conducting the same activity and how the applicant will address any harm that could flow from this.

The final point of concern is the hours proposed by this applicant are extensive, 06.00hrs if granted will be the earliest in the locality and in area with this many off licences this does cause concern.

The Licensing Authority in their capacity as Responsible authority are opposed to the grant of any new Off Licences in the Saturation areas especially where the offer is just another similar to the type of business already established in the area. I can see nothing unique or special that would justify departure from the Licensing Authority's policy to refuse new applications in this ward.
