5.2 The rank of average scores shows that Blackpool is the most deprived local authority area in the country, and the most deprived based on health measures. This reflects both the concentration of health issues in Blackpool and their relevance to the wider determinants of health.

5.3 The findings should be considered by the board alongside the detailed evidence in the Blackpool Joint Strategic Needs Assessment, as the board develops a new Health and Wellbeing Strategy for the town.
