17/0060	ANCHORSHOLME PARK, ANCHORSHOLME LANE EAST	<ul> <li>Head of Highways and Traffic Management: Some points below which may require discussion.</li> <li>1. The footpath within the park which leads to the southern edge of the site (towards Bispham Tram Loop) to tie-in with the existing path. This is required to maintain pedestrian connectivity to Princess Way/Parade/Beach.</li> <li>2. The scope of works for the vehicle access point onto Princes Way to be discussed and agreed with Traffic and Highways.</li> <li>3. The footpath into the park from Anchorsholme Lane West is shown to be wider than existing. The existing vehicle crossing must be modified to take this change into account.</li> <li>4. The vehicle access into the main facility building is remaining in-situ. Currently visibility is good and this should remain as existing.</li> <li>5. A Construction Management Plan was conditioned as part of the permission in 2015 (15/0280). This condition has been discharged and the work is being managed effectively. Any change or variation during construction to how the work is being delivered (which may affect the operation of the highway network) to be discussed and agreed with Traffic and Highways</li> </ul>
