

Proposed conditions

1. Risk assessments carried out by or on behalf of the licence holder which relate to a licensing objective will be available for inspection by the enforcement authorities.
2. Clear legible and conspicuous notices requesting patrons to avoid causing noise, nuisance or disturbance to local residents shall be displayed at every exit.
3. The licence holder and designated premises supervisor are to support and rigorously enforce the Challenge 21 proof of age policy. Any person who looks or appears to be under the age of 21 shall be asked to provide identification that they are over the age of 21.
4. Any person who looks or appears to be under the age of 21 shall be asked to provide identification that they are over the age of 18. The following are the only forms of identification acceptable: -
 - i. UK photo driving licence
 - ii. Passport
 - iii. Proof of Age Standards Scheme card.
5. All members of staff are to have received suitable training in relation to the proof of age scheme to be applied upon the premises. Records to evidence this will be made available to an authorised officer upon request.
6. Any individual employed on the premises to carry out a security activity must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
