I would like to object to the licence for late hour being placed by the Lawton hotel on Charnley road. by Darren Wilkinson and Malcolm Daley.

I live on Westwell Grove opposite the Lawton hotel and believe that any variation on licence would have a detrimental effect on the residents of Westwell Grove, the following I state in my list below.

1. Prevention of public nuisance.

I have been witness to the police attending the Lawton on numerous occasions due to behaviour of their guests. As we currently have two un gated alleyways on Westwell Grove, I have also been witness during the day and evening of guests of this hotel trashing down the alley as well as on three occasions last year having sex down the

alleyway (as my children are young I wish to protect them from the visuals of this.)

On occasion there has also been drug taking and when challenged they have confirmed they have been residents of the Beechfield or Lanton hotel.

Prevention crime and disorder.

On 4 occasions last year residents of the Lanton and Beechfield hotel using Westwell Grove as a shortcut, damaged parked vehicles outside our property, and on one occasion a drunk guest kicked the mirror of my vehicle clean off causing £20.00 worth of damage.

There is the constant use of foul language by these guests, some of which my children have heard. We have families on this street I don't think Mr Wilkinson has considered this my own son who has special need suffers from anxiety and his condition has worsened he is 6 years old, and this is without a variation in licence.

the safety and well being of my family  
is paramount and I strongly object to  
this licence being issued, so much so I  
have penned a letter to Paul Maynard MP  
and to the chief constable. I await their  
responses.

I would also point out that both hotels fall  
out the area for this sort of licence.
