## **ENHANCED PARTNERSHIP NOTICE**

### **Notice of Intent to Prepare an Enhanced Partnership Plan and Schemes 29th June 2021**

Through Cabinet Member decision (28th June 2021), Blackpool Council gave approval to proceed with the development of an Enhanced Partnership. The commencement of this is confirmed through this notice of the intention to prepare an Enhanced Partnership Plan and accompanying Enhanced Partnership Schemes, as required and set out in section 138F of the Transport Act 2000.

The Proposed Scheme as currently envisaged will cover the Blackpool Council administrative area, also incorporating agreements with Lancashire County Council concerning cross-border issues including service frequencies and inter-operator ticketing.

The Bus Services Act 2017 amended the 2000 Act to provide the Authority with powers to reform the bus market and these provisions provide for new types of partnership schemes.
