<p>My role as Child Protection Licensing Officer focusses on managing the various risks that makes both children and adults unsafe; alcohol constituting a significant risk factor.</p> <p>On behalf of Blackpool Council Community Safety I object to the application for a premises licence at Sherbourne Convenience Store, 80 Sherbourne Road, Blackpool.</p> <p>The premises is situated within the Claremont Ward, which is included in the cumulative impact area. The application is for a convenience store supplying alcohol by way of off sales 10am to 10pm 7 days a week. The Blackpool Cumulative Impact Assessment 2021 in Figure 1 shows that that Claremont Ward already has 22 off licence premises.</p> <p>I am concerned that based on the application the applicant has been given as to how the operation would not add to existing problems in the area.</p> <p>I would recommend that this application is refused.</p>
