When we first purchased our guest house in 2016, Khan'z Chippy was a family fish & chip shop/café, with family-friendly opening hours. Our guests often used this café and we had no problems with noise, etc. We built our custom based on providing accommodation suitable for families and couples and have a good clientele now.

Since it was sold, the property remained empty for some time, so we were glad to see that it had been bought and refurbished. The new tenant told us it was going to be a fish & chip shop again, so we tolerated noise from the renovations at unsociable hours, on Sundays and Bank Holidays, etc.

Now we find it is just another kebab shop and are sad to see the late night licence until 3am, as we are sure it will have a detrimental impact on our business. Four of our rooms (two of them our largest family rooms) overlook our front yard and we are worried - having seen the noise and behaviour that happens outside other takeaways locally — that this will have a huge effect on our customer satisfaction and in turn, on our future bookings. I personally would not want to take my own children on holiday somewhere right next to a late night/early hours takeaway, nor would I want to stay there myself if I had a room overlooking it.

We are also concerned about the amount of rubbish which will be thrown into our yard and it is likely that some takeaway customers will use our own guest seating (as we are right next door) to eat their food, so we are concerned about the resulting mess, as well as the noise and behaviour.

We do not host stag/hen groups for the same reasons as our concerns about the takeaway and we make it clear on our website/social media that this is the case. Families do not want to go out with their children and then, once they have all settled down in bed, be kept awake until 3am.

We were hoping that the council would make a condition that bins were provided outside the takeaway, otherwise there will be rubbish everywhere, as well as in our own yard.

Your conditions say that the operators must ensure the outside of the shop is kept clean and all glass bottles will be put in a bin. We are not confident this will happen, as glass fluorescent light tubes from the renovations have been sat outside the shop (against our wall) for weeks on end, which they have not yet bothered to dispose of. Some of these were smashed over our railings a few weeks ago and we had to clean the mess up inside and outside our yard, but still the tenants and owners of next door have not cleared the remaining glass tubes away from their frontage.
