(VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) AND (REVOCATIONS) BATCH ORDER No 1 2021

NOTICE is hereby given that Blackpool Borough Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1,2,3,4, 53 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the “Act of 1984”) and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 , and under the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the “Act of 2004”) and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to introduce or remove the following restrictions on lengths of the roads specified below:-
