## Review of Logs Summary

On Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> November we met with PS Cox and PC Pritchard to discuss the incident logs produced as part of the review process. A table was produced for the 13 months from August 21 to August 22 with a traffic light system. Green is not relevant or connected to the premises. Amber requires more detail and discussion regarding connection to premises and concerns. Reds are incidents of concern that require us to pin down causation factors linked to the premises.

Out of the logs stated in the review 103 are Green and agreed with the police that they are not relevant to the premises.

155 amber logs required further detail as to confirm that they are attributable to the premises as the majority have a legitimate explanation and the premises are working to the best of their ability whilst working proactively with the police and producing documentary support were possible.

Throughout the 13 month period there are 8 logs identified as red but these stand alone incidents have not been one to warrant immediate closure from the authorities. In the review document it refers to knife related incidents which causes one alarm and serious concern when reading such crime and disorder but when looking further into the police logs it transpires some knives have actually been a hair brush and a females false nails.

The police have requested incident reports at the meeting and these are attached for perusal.
