We would like to make a formal complaint against the application submitted by the Post Office at [27 Whitegate Drive, Blackpool, FY3 9AA](#), to extend their licensing hours to sell alcohol [from 8am until 3am](#). This proposal is at odds with the main function of the site as a Post Office and also goes against the local plan that is laid down by the council to protect local communities and the environment.

The proposed extra hours would cause considerable nuisance in an area that is heavily residential, and residents would suffer from increased noise and anti-social behaviour if this application were granted. Many local residents feel, like me, that this would be a detriment to the community, it would also cause considerable nuisance at night and into the early hours of the morning.
