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I have noticed the property that adjoins my address has applied to have a license to serve food to unsociable hours and wish to object to this being granted.

The premises is Downtown Grill, 111 Elizabeth St, Blackpool FY1 3LZ.

This property is directly below my young daughter's bedroom and adjacent to my living room. As it is, it regularly stays open to 2am midweek and 3am on the weekends. The delivery drivers sit with their headlights on park on the footpath and on resident only areas.

The noise from the kebab shop is quite loud and disturbs both my and my daughter's sleep. I don't believe that it should be permitted to open to these late hours. On their brochures they actually advertise that they are open until 2am at weekends, however this is in conflict as to the hours they are requesting.

I have lived at this property for 8 years and never had an issue with the takeaway as it previously closed at 11pm. this is a residential area with families and young children in the surrounding properties.
